This will acknowledge your letter of September 18, addressed to Mr. Walter A. Haas, relative to the proposed re-routing of O'Shaughnessy Boulevard which you say will cut through Glen Park.

It is the objective of this Commission to protect park lands for the enjoyment of the people of San Francisco.
